

DOMINIQUE RENSON

THEY, Witches, Sibyls

From 30 January to 22 March 2025

Opening with the presence of the artist Thursday 30 January from 6 pm to 8.30 pm

Dominique Renson (Paris, 1956) lives and works in Paris and Béziers where she is in residence with Ecluses de l'Art at the Moulin Cordier.

"Anyone interested in the human body and its contemporary artistic representations benefits from knowing the plastic work of Dominique Renson.

This artist, with recognized maturity, paints our bodies like no other, fragility and bursts of sensitive emotion combined, in the great vein of expressionist realism (...)

Painting by Dominique Renson portraitist cultivates without mask a normality always coupled with a charge of enigma and strangeness.

Normality: the painted people exist, are very real.

Enigma and strangeness: who are these people, beyond appearance?

MAZARINE VARIATIONS

For the exhibition at Galerie Mazarine Variations, Dominique Renson presents a series of 14 oils on canvas, all women, known or not, painted between 2011 and 2024, and one set of recent still lifes, with a silver timbal which can be found in a recurring on each painting. The timbal being the metaphor for the witch's cauldron.
